


How to register your laptop with the LightspeedGuide content filter

Staff and faculty laptop computers that are connected to non-District networks (such as your home or a public network) must first be registered with our content filter using your account credentials. This is a one-time registration and you will be able to continue using the Internet with your computer once it is complete. Registration can only be performed while connected to a non-District network.

When you are prompted with the following message, please enter the ESASD network domain name, nexus, followed by a backslash (\) along with your network username (firstname-lastname). For example, if your name is John Doe, enter **nexus\john-doe** in the Username field. Then enter your password and click Submit.


