

“ESASD Alumni Who Are Serving Our Country” Information Board Guidelines

1. Students must keep in mind that the letter they send may be the only one the soldier receives for several weeks.
2. Letters or cards must be neat and spelled correctly.
3. Suggestions for topics: write something about yourself, favorite subjects, hobbies, music, future plans, etc. Write something to show concern for the soldier(s) to whom they write (e.g., encouragement, gratitude, non-personal questions, etc.). Letters or cards must be free of personal or political opinions and simply convey human concern.
4. If students are interested in receiving correspondence in return, they can indicate that on the letter and make sure they give the school address with their name and in care of the teacher whose class they are in.
5. All forms of communication related to the information board is subject to teacher review and approval. This is a school-sponsored “pen pal” activity, not a forum for the expression of individual political opinion or overly personal communication.
