### Nurses Corner:

Some tips about “Flu”, Flu season is here!!

**PLEASE KEEP SICK CHILDREN HOME FROM SCHOOL. THEY SHOULD BE FEVER FREE FOR 24 HOURS TO RETURN TO SCHOOL, WITHOUT TAKING FEVER REDUCING MEDICINE.**

The best prevention is the Flu vaccination, it can reduce flu illnesses, doctors’ visits, and missed work and school due to flu, as well as prevent flu-related hospitalizations.

View the **Center for Disease Control website** for other valuable information.

- Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
  - While sick, limit contact with others as much as possible to keep from infecting them.
  - if you are sick with flu symptoms, the CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone except to get medical care or for other necessities. (Your fever should be gone for 24 hours without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.)

Dear Parents:

Please, please, please dress your child in appropriate clothing for the cold weather.

This means:

- a winter coat
- a winter hat
- winter mittens or gloves

**YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO GO OUTSIDE IF THEY DO NOT HAVE A COAT.**
