Nurses Corner

Some tips about "Flu", Flu season is here!!

PLEASE KEEP SICK CHILDREN HOME FROM SCHOOL. THEY SHOULD BE FEVER FREE FOR 24 HOURS TO RETURN TO SCHOOL, WITHOUT TAKING FEVER REDUCING MEDICINE.

The best prevention is the Flu vaccination, it can reduce flu illnesses, doctors' visits, and missed work and school due to flu, as well as prevent flu-related hospitalizations.

View the Center for Disease Control website for other valuable information.

- Try to avoid close contact with sick people.
 - While sick, limit contact with others as much as possible to keep from infecting them.
 - if you are sick with flu symptoms, the CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone except to get medical care or for other necessities. (Your fever should be gone for 24 hours without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.)
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it. Teach your children to cough into their sleeve and wash their hands frequently.
- [Wash your hands](#) often with soap and water. If soap and water are not available, use an [alcohol-based hand rub](#).
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth. Germs spread this way.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with germs like the flu.
- If you think your child has the flu, keep them home and take them to your health care provider to be tested for the flu. Antiviral medications can be prescribed.
- Signs and symptoms of the flu may include, fever*, cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, chills, fatigue, and sometimes vomiting and diarrhea. *It's important to note that not everyone with flu will have a fever.
